Our Services

Assessment

Intake Assessments (IA) include:

- A comprehensive records review.
- A meeting with parents, caregivers and/or school staff as appropriate.
- Completion of a direct assessment of the child.

Following completion of the IA, the NECC Clinic supervisory team will provide recommendations for the number of hours of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy, Speech and Language (SL) therapy and/or Occupational Therapy (OT) per week, the number of hours of BCBA, SLP and/or OT supervision required for successful program development and the locations of where the clients' sessions would be most beneficial.

Clinic-Based Services

Each clients' individualised program will be developed by the supervising BCBA, SLP and/or OT, and implemented by a team of fully trained and supervised Registered Behavior Technicians (RBT).

Speech and language and/or OT goals will be developed and overseen by a certified SLP/OT.

Home, school and community-based sessions will be made available based on measurable performance and clinical recommendations. These sessions involve parent, caregiver and teacher/LSA support and training in order to facilitate the transfer of skills to the client's natural environment.

Consultation Services

BCBA, SLP and/or OT consultation involves providing direct supervisory support to families, caregivers and school teams.

Support may be delivered in the form of training, positive behavior support strategies, clinical support and guidance with decision making related to client needs, and collaboration with the family and any other agencies involved in the clients' team.

Consultation is delivered in the settings clinically deemed to be most appropriate for ensuring client progress and success.

Overview of Fees

Clinic-based ABA sessions are fully inclusive of a NECC, highly trained behavior therapist, frequent on-going BCBA supervision, access to the ACE curriculum program where appropriate, all reports and parent meetings and parent/caregiver training embedded. There are no additional hidden costs.

Clinic-based and consultation fees are determined based on the services required and number of agreed upon hours.
