¿Cómo inscribir a mi hijo en ACT?

Para inscribir a su hijo, siga estos sencillos pasos:

1. Visite nuestro sitio web.
2. Haga clic en el botón "Registrar a su hijo".
3. Complete los cuatro pasos indicados en la página de registro.
4. Después de enviar su solicitud, espere de 1 a 2 días hábiles para recibir una respuesta de nuestro equipo.
5. Si no recibe respuesta después de 2 días hábiles, no dude en llamarnos para hacer un seguimiento.

¿Cuáles son los requisitos de inscripción?

1. Un informe de diagnóstico de autismo para su hijo.
2. El niño debe tener menos de 20 años.
3. Se requiere un seguro médico aceptado.

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Therapy is the gold standard for helping children with Autism reach their potential. At Autism Care Therapy, our customized programs enhance communication, social skills, and behavior through positive reinforcement, enabling children to grow and make meaningful progress in their lives.

Speech Therapy

Speech therapy, led by speech-language pathologists (SLPs), focuses on improving communication and speech disorders through assessments and tailored treatment goals using effective techniques.

Occupational Therapy (OT)

Occupational Therapy helps children with Autism thrive by using personalized, play-based activities to build essential skills like dressing, eating, and writing, while also enhancing sensory regulation and emotional balance.

Preschool Program (Little Bears)

Our (Little Bears) program helps children ages 2–6 develop essential skills through fun, play-based ABA therapy.

Children learn communication, social interaction, group participation, and daily routines. We focus on building independence, confidence, and school readiness in a playful environment.

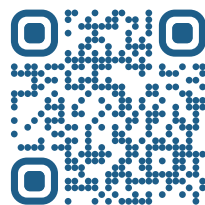
