Day Center

Our day program caters to children between the ages of 4-18 years, offering a total of Twelve classrooms and running from 8.15AM-1.30PM. Each classroom has one SEN Teacher and at least two/three teaching assistants with between six to seven students. All staff are trained and receive ongoing training on how to effectively deliver and/or modify Curriculum's for our students. During the day program, students receive both 1:1 OT and SLT. Outside of set curriculum goals there is a large focus on play, social, and daily living skills, all staff are trained in Makaton Sign Language, PECS, and Proloquo2go and employ these as necessary for our students. All classrooms also actively practice sensory integration a necessity for our students. This day program is overseen by our resident BCBA.

Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapy (OT) helps individuals develop and/or regain skills important for independent functioning, health and well-being. An OT can identify strengths and difficulties, such as dressing or writing, and will help work out practical solutions. OT's work from a holistic perspective, in that the focus is on adapting the environment to fit the person, our OT's recognize the common sensory processing barriers affecting those with Autism Spectrum Disorders, and are trained to provide sensory integration, which focuses primarily on three basic senses: tactile, vestibular, and proprioceptive. Our OTs are able to provide assessments and treatment plans for children, adolescents and adults with a broad range of diagnoses.



ABA Therapy

Therapy based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is at the core of what we do at Safe Center. Employing evidence-based behavior analytic methods, we are able to identify the student's developmental priorities and create an individualized program accordingly. Our programs target skill deficits where we aim to increase appropriate skills such as communication, and target behavior excesses where we aim to decrease inappropriate behavior such as aggression's. Through the use of rigorous data collection, we are able to track the effectiveness of each program, and make any necessary modifications in a timely manner. ABA principles are used when teaching students attending our day school program. Our ABA therapists are Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs) and receive supervision from a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). Our behavior Therapists are able to provide assessments and treatment plans for children, adolescents and adults with a broad range of diagnoses.

Swimming

Swimming is fun and it can help strengthen the muscles which increase the balance and develops better range of motions.



SLT Therapy

Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) plays a vital role in the assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of Autism Spectrum Disorders. Our SLT's are able to assess speech, language, cognitive-communication, and oral/feeding/swallowing skills our SLT's are also able to identify types of communication problems such as: articulation; fluency; voice; receptive and expressive language disorders and the best way to treat them. Our SLT's are fluently trained in: Makaton Sign Language; ASL Sign Language; Hanan; PECS; and other AAC devices such as proloquo2go and quick talker. Our SLTs are able to provide assessments and treatment plans for children, adolescents and adults with a broad range of diagnoses.



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
